The ArcGIS platform is continuously evolving with new capabilities being introduced all the time. This course will show you how the platform connects maps, apps, data, and people in ways that help organisations make more informed and faster decisions, extending the reach of GIS across the enterprise. ArcGIS accomplishes this by making it easy for everyone in an organisation to discover, use, make, and share maps from any device, anywhere, anytime.

Furthermore, ArcGIS is designed to be flexible, offering these capabilities through multiple implementation patterns and approaches.

Using four areas of the ArcGIS platform (ArcGIS Pro, ArcGIS Online, AppStudio and Operations Dashboard) you will discover how easy it is to construct an Asset Collection application and then display and analyse those assets to a wider audience.

- See how you can publish these feature classes to ArcGIS Online for use within other areas of the ArcGIS platform
- Build a lightweight application using AppStudio for ArcGIS without the need for programming skills
- Go out and collect assets using your Asset Collection application
- Add you assets to a web map in ArcGIS Online
- Build an Common Operating Picture using Operations Dashboard for ArcGIS to share with a wider audience the information collected and answer questions about your assets
